Consequent upon additional allotment of Wheat conveyed by the Administrative Department vide above referred communication under PHH category for the purpose of Intra-State Portability (ONORC) for Nomadic Gujjar and Bakerwal families of district Anantnag. The Assistant Director Stores/ Mills FCS&CA Kashmir are hereby authorized for:

1. Lifting of 300.00 Qtls of Wheat from FCI under PHH category (Intra-State - ONORC) out of the monthly allocation of October 2024.
2. Release of 300.00 Qtls of Wheat under PHH category (Intra-State) in favour of Assistant Director FCS&CA Anantnag to facilitate Intra-State Portability (ONORC) transactions for Nomadic Gujjar and Bakerwal families of district Anantnag for the current and upcoming months as per availability and demand.
3. Allocation of 300.00 Qtls of Wheat under PHH category (Intra-State) in favour of Assistant Director FCS&CA Anantnag for the purpose of Nomadic Gujjar and Bakerwal families for current and upcoming months.

The concerned Assistant Directors shall ensure lifting/ dispatch of entire released quantity to the respective sale outlets within the stipulated time for its further distribution amongst the genuine beneficiaries through Intra-State Portability with the condition that all the distribution of Foodgrains should be through PoS devices only strictly as per the entitlements and no manual distribution is allowed as directed earlier

The concerned Assistant Director shall generate additional release order through Aepds for the FPS/ Govt. SCs from where the additional quantity is to be distributed.

The Assistant Directors shall ensure proper record of transactions, reconciliation and monitoring of foodgrains for greater transparency as per the guidelines of the Administrative Department as well as from this Directorate.
