Subject: -Advance lifting/Allocation of Foodgrains (Rice, Wheat and Sugar) under NFSA, NPHH, PMFSS and JKSSS for Main Border Areas of Kupwara and Gurez (Bandipora).

Consequent upon the authorization for lifting of advance quantity and utilization of available savings of Foodgrains conveyed by the Administrative Department in respect of 2024-25 under NFSA (AAY+PHH category) and Non- Priority Households (NPHH-Tide over), PMFSS and JKSSS for its advance dumping in the border areas which remain cut off during winters due to snow, the Assistant Director Stores/ Mills FCS&CA Kashmir are hereby authorized for:

1. Advance Procurement/Lifting of Rice under NFSA/ NPHH to the extent of **4944.96 Qtls under AAY, 10599.34 Qtls under PHH and 3370.44 Qtls under NPHH categories out of the allocation for the year 2024-25** from FCI by or before 15th of October 2024.
2. Procurement/Lifting of Rice for PMFSS to the extent of **4174.74 Qtls** from FCI at OMSS (D) rates by or before 15th of October 2024 for the purpose of advance dumping in respect of Border Areas of Kupwara for the period December 2024 to June 2025.

Sanction is also hereby accorded for:

1. Advance Release of Foodgrains to the extent of **23848.05 Qtls viz 22441.06 Qtls of Rice and 1406.99 Qtls of Wheat under NFSA/NPHH** in favour of Assistant Director FCS&CA Kupwara and Bandipora for the purpose of advance dumping in respect of Border Areas of Kupwara and Gurez (Bandipora) for the period of December 2024 to June 2025 as per the district wise breakup given at **Annexure "A"** to this order.
2. Advance Release of Rice to the extent of **5187.25 Qtls** under PMFSS for the period of December 2024 to June 2025 in favour of respective Assistant Directors as per the district wise breakup given at **Annexure "B"** to this order.

3. Advance Release of Sugar to the extent of 245.38 Qtls under JKSSS out of available savings available at divisional level for the purpose of advance dumping at border areas in favour of Assistant Directors of FCS&CA Kupwara and Bandipora for the period of Oct-24 to Jun-25 as per the district wise breakup given at Annexure "C" to this order.

The concerned Assistant Directors shall ensure lifting/ dispatch of entire released quantity to the respective Dumping centres/sale outlets as per the online allocation made in the "FEAST" module after deduction of closing balance of each FPS within the stipulated time for its further distribution (as and when authorized) amongst bonafide rationees in the respective months through PoS devices only as per the scale/ entitlement notified by the Government under respective schemes/ categories, unless changed earlier.

The allocation is however, subject to the fulfillment of terms and conditions conveyed from time to time. Besides, the Assistant Directors shall ensure:

- a) The allocated quantity is lifted from the specified loading point within the stipulated time as per the guidelines conveyed by the Administrative Department.
- b) The quantity shall be dispatched/ dumped to the respective sale outlets/ dumping stations within the stipulated timeframe.
- c) The quantity is released for advance lifting, dispatch and dumping purpose only, the authorization for distribution shall be conveyed separately.
- d) The real time Supply Chain Management (SCM) shall be followed strictly by all the concerned and any departure shall invite disciplinary action against the concerned Assistant Director.
- e) No Diversion/ re-appropriation from one scheme to another & one category to another is allowed.
- f) The un-lifted quantity, if any, owing to failure by any District, shall be correspondingly deducted from the next month's allocation and the un-lifted quantity shall not be re-allotted during the next month.
- g) The entire quantity for a particular centre out of the allocations due for the month shall be stored as per FIFO methodology to avoid deterioration.
- h) The ADs shall ensure implementation of the above terms and conditions in letter and spirit. Deviation, if any, shall attract disciplinary action against the erring officer and officials.

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
