Consequent upon the instructions conveyed by the Administrative Department for completion of winter dumping of Foodgrains in the required areas which remain affected during winters due to snow as per past practice, the **Assistant Director Stores/ Mills FCS&CA Kashmir are hereby authorized for:**

 Advance Procurement/Lifting of Foodgrains to the extent of 255160.49 Qtls of Rice and 9705.21 Qtls of Wheat under NFSA/ NPHH from FCI for the period Dec-24 to Mar-25 out of the allocation for the year 2024-25 as per the category wise breakup given hereunder:

- 3. Advance Release of Foodgrains to the extent of 255160.49 Qtls of Rice and 11752.85 Qtls of Wheat under NFSA/NPHH in favour of Assistant Directors, FCS&CA of Kashmir Division except Srinagar for the purpose of advance dumping in respect of Snow Bound areas for the period of December 2024 to March 2025 as per the district wise breakup given at Annexure "A" to this order.
- 4. Advance Release of 55030.00 Qtis of Rice under PMFSS for the period of December 2024 to March 2025 in favour of respective Assistant Directors as per the district-wise breakup given at Annexure "A" to this order.
- 5. Advance Release of 1510.32 Qtls of Sugar under JKSSS out of available savings available at divisional level for advance dumping in respect of Snow Bound areas for the period of Jan-25 to Mar-25 as per the district-wise breakup given at Annexure "A" to this order.



The concerned Assistant Directors shall ensure lifting/ dispatch of entire released quantity to the respective Dumping centres/sale outlets as per the online allocation made in the "FEAST" module after deduction of closing balance of each FPS within the stipulated time for its further distribution (as and when authorized) amongst bonafide rationees in the respective months through PoS devices only as per the scale/ entitlement notified by the Government under respective schemes/ categories, unless changed earlier. Besides, only the required quantity of Foodgrains be dumped at the Snow Bound areas and no excess quantity shall be stored in such areas as the PoS balance for respective months shall be deducted in full and hence the stocks shall be adjusted accordingly.

The allocation is however, subject to the fulfillment of terms and conditions conveyed from time to time. Besides, the Assistant Directors shall ensure:

- a. The allocated quantity is lifted from the specified loading point within the stipulated time as per the guidelines conveyed by the Administrative Department.
- b. The quantity shall be dispatched/ dumped to the respective sale outlets/ dumping stations within the stipulated timeframe.
- C. The quantity is released for advance lifting, dispatch and dumping purpose only, the authorization for distribution shall be conveyed separately.
- d. The real time Supply Chain Management (SCM) shall be followed strictly by all the concerned and any departure shall invite disciplinary action against the concerned Assistant Director.
- e. No Diversion/ re-appropriation from one scheme to another & one category to another is allowed.
- f. The un-lifted quantity, if any, owing to failure by any District, shall be correspondingly deducted from the next month's allocation and the un-lifted quantity shall not be re-allotted during the next month.
- g. The entire quantity for a particular centre out of the allocations due for the month shall be stored as per FIFO methodology to avoid deterioration.
- h. The ADs shall ensure implementation of the above terms and conditions in letter and spirit. Deviation, if any, shall attract disciplinary action against the erring officer and officials.
