The Assistant Director Stores/ Mills FCS&CA Kashmir are hereby authorized for:

3. Allocation of **735.86 Qtls of Foodgrains viz; 304.13 Qtls of Rice and 431.73 Qtls of Wheat** under NFSA for the purpose of Inter-State National Portability ONORC in favour of Assistant Directors of FCS&CA Kashmir Division for the 2nd Quarter 2023-2024 as per the district wise breakup given at Annexure "A" to this order.

The concerned Assistant Directors shall ensure lifting/ dispatch of entire released quantity to the respective sale outlets within the stipulated time under Inter-State/ National Portability ONORC for the respective period as per the instructions of the Administrative Department. Besides, mass publicity should be ensured at grass root level to promote portability.

The Assistant Directors shall ensure proper record of transactions, reconciliation and monitoring of foodgrains for greater transparency.


