Consequent upon allotment of foodgrains conveyed by the Administrative Department vide above referred communication under NFSA for the purpose of Inter-State/ National Portability (ONORC) for the **4<sup>th</sup> Quarter (January 2024 to March 2024)**. The Assistant Director Stores/ Mills FCS&CA Kashmir are hereby authorized to:

1. Lifting of **139.96 Qtls of Foodgrains viz; 38.70 Qtls of Rice and 101.26 Qtls of Wheat** from FCI by or before **10<sup>th</sup> of May, 2024** under NFSA (Inter-State/ National Portability) ONORC for the **4<sup>th</sup> Quarter 2023-2024**.
2. Release of **139.96 Qtls of Foodgrains viz; 38.70 Qtls of Rice and 101.26 Qtls of Wheat** under NFSA for the purpose of Inter-State National Portability ONORC in favour of Assistant Directors of FCS&CA Kashmir Division for the **4<sup>th</sup> Quarter 2023-2024** as per the district wise breakup given at **Annexure "A"** to this order.

The concerned Assistant Directors shall ensure the lifting/ dispatch of entire released quantity to the respective sale outlets through online mode within the stipulated time under Inter-State/ National Portability ONORC for the respective period as per the instructions of the Government. Besides, publicity at grass-root level to promote portability transactions.




