

Consequent upon the allotment of Foodgrains made by Administrative Department vide above referred communication out of the central allocation for J&K under NFSA for distribution in the month of July-2022 so as to promote transactions under ONORC across J&K, Assistant Director Stores/ Mills FCS&CA Kashmir is hereby authorized for lifting /procurement of 72.00 Qtls of Foodgrains viz; 36.00 Qtls of Rice and 36.00 Qtls of Wheat from FCI under NFSA for its further release in favour of Assistant Directors of FCS&CA Kashmir Division for the month of July 2022 as per the district wise breakup given in Annexure "A" to this order for the purpose of Inter-State/ National Portability (ONORC).


The concerned Assistant Directors shall ensure lifting/ dispatch of entire released quantity for its further distribution amongst deserving beneficiaries through PoS devices for the month of July 2022 under NFSA strictly as per the directions of the Administrative Department specifically in respect of distribution ratios i.e. 70.99 : 29.01 to be adopted for Rice and Wheat respectively duly conveyed vide communication referred herein above (copy enclosed).

The Assistant Directors shall ensure mass publicity at grass root level to promote portability for maximizing transactions through the concerned field officers/ officials and other functionaries.



The Assistant Directors shall ensure proper recording of receipts and distribution on monthly basis (transaction wise) so that monthly reports are sought and submitted as per the directions of Administrative Department.

The above allocation is subject to the fulfillment of other terms and conditions conveyed from time to time.



Subject: Allocation of advance food grains for the purpose of **ONORC** under **NFSA** for the month of July, 2022.

Reference:

- i) Letter No. F.No.9 (I)/2019-Comp.Cell (E:367771) dated: 16-02-2022 of Department of Food & Public Distribution, Government of India.
- ii) Letter No. 1-4/2019-BP-III(e-368491) dated: 14-03-2022 of Department of Food & Public Distribution, Government of India.

Sir,

Whereas, it has been observed that FPS Dealers are not encouraging ONORC transactions with the right focus so as to allow the beneficiaries to avail maximum benefits out of the ONORC scheme.

Whereas, Director Kashmir vide letter No. DFCS&CA/Plg/2022/6551-52 dated: 24.05.2022 and Director Jammu vide letter No: DFCSAJ/P&S/2022-23/ONORC/94 dated: 25.05.2022 have recommended to allow advance lifting of foodgrains to help them promote **ONORC** transactions, across Jammu & Kashmir.

Whereas, it has been observed that for the purpose of **ONORC** under **NFSA** scheme, the Department has to facilitate so that the desired beneficiaries get benefits under this flagship programme and this prestigious programme is encouraged across J&K.

Whereas, the matter has been considered in light of Department of Food and Public Distribution, GoI's communication No. F.No. 9 (I)/ 2019-Comp. Cell (E: 367771) dated: 16-02-2022. In light of this it has been decided:-

- i) Director, FCS&CA Jammu/ Kashmir shall lift advance foodgrains to the following extent, out of central allocation for J&K under NFSA for the month of **October, 2022** for its distribution during the month of **July, 2022**, so as to promote transactions under **ONORC** across Jammu & Kashmir and they shall ensure that no beneficiaries are refused to get benefit under **ONORC**.

- ii) Since the allocation of foodgrains under NFSA for the purpose of interstate/ national portability is being done by the Government of India in the ratio 70.99:29.01 for rice and wheat, respectively, in respect of Jammu & Kashmir, the distribution under ONORC should be restricted to above ratios (commodity wise) as far as possible and practical.
- iii) Both the Directorates shall ensure mass publicity at grass root level to promote **ONORC** across J&K for maximizing transactions.
- iv) The food grains shall be lifted immediately.
- v) There shall be an Overseeing and Monitoring Committee comprising the following to ensure that reconciliations are made at all levels, across Jammu & Kashmir, smoothly in respect of advance lifting, and with FCI and GoI, under the **ONORC** Scheme.
1. Deputy Director (Planning), Department of FCS&CA (Chairman)
 2. Deputy Director (Planning), Directorate of FCS&CA, Kashmir- (Member)
 3. Deputy Director (Planning), Directorate of FCS&CA, Jammu- (Member)
 4. Project Manager (SPMU), Department of FCS&CA- (Member)
 5. One DPMU, to be nominated by each Director- (Member).
